Plan Your Trip

The peak season for the PNT in Glacier National Park falls between July1st and September 28th. Advance permits can be reserved online at Recreation.gov starting on March 15th. Permits must be picked up in person at a permitting location.

NPS Backcountry Camp, Permits Required Non-Federal Lands Walk-up permits can be requested the day before, or on the day of, a desired trip start date by visiting a ranger station in the Park. PNT hikers may be granted a high-mileage permit at a ranger's discretion.

There is no guarantee that a walk-in permit application will be successful. Only 30% of permits are reserved for walk-in registration, and the sites you hope to reserve may have been taken by others well in advance. It is recommended to arrive early at least one day before your intended start date.
